Sponsorship consists of a \$200 per year commitment for 5 years. Each year the sponsor receives a year plate to mount on the plaque.

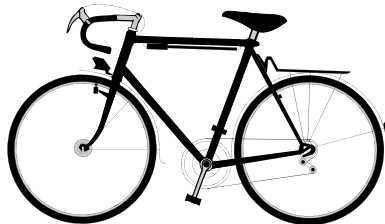
All sponsors will be featured at our major events, on our web site and on social media whenever possible.

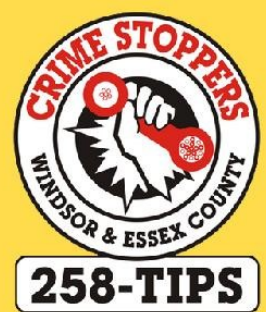
