We thank Lina for her years of dedicated service and leadership throughout. She will be missed!

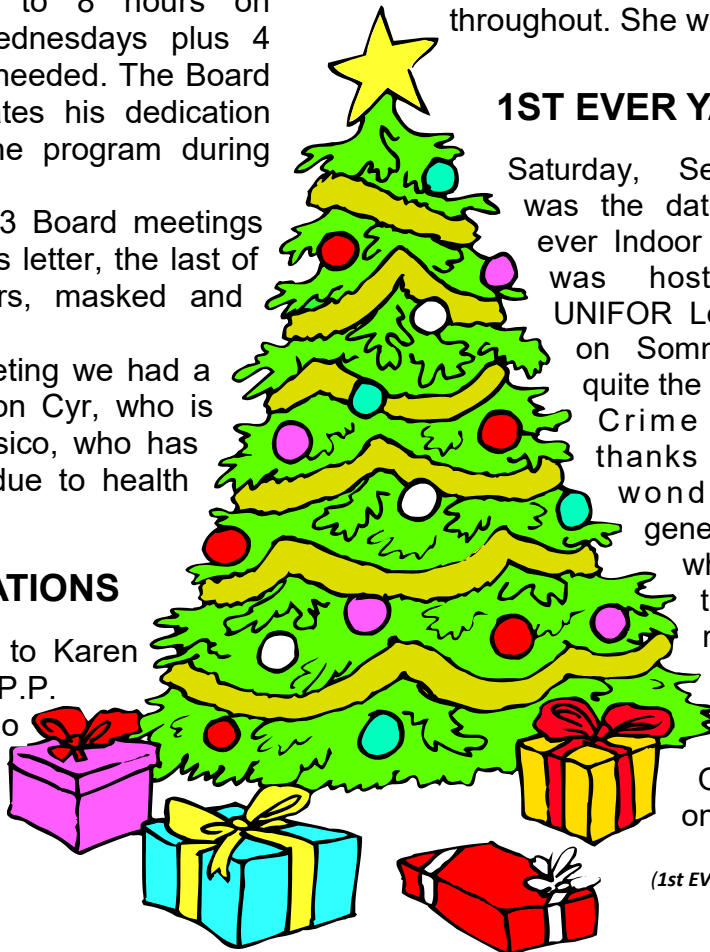
### 1ST EVER YARD SALE

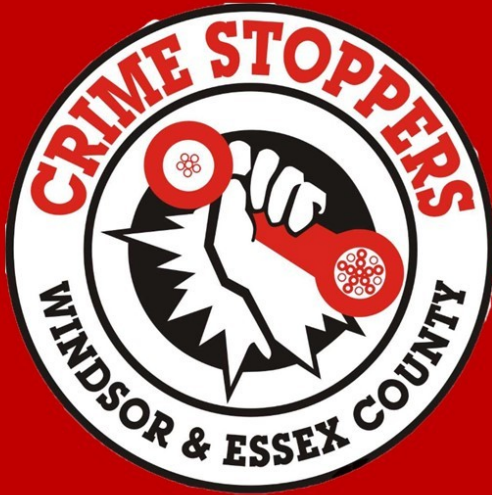
