#### CRIME STOPPERS GOLF TOURNAMENT AUG. 24TH

The Crime Stoppers Golf Tournament will be held at Kingsville Golf & Country Club on Thursday, August 24th. Kingsville has 3 courses (starting points) - Red/White, White/Gold, Gold/Red.

We can accommodate a total of 42 foursomes (168 golfers). On our website the registrants can choose their tee time/course. The tee times start at 11am and go until 12:37pm. Cost is \$175 per golfer or \$700 per foursome. There is also Mulligans for those who wish to participate.

There is VIP bag drop off provided by the course. The golfers pull up, drop off their bag and the course places it on the cart for them. In their registration package, golfers are given 25 raffle tickets. Golfers are issued a voucher for lunch in the registration package.

Because there are 3 courses, if we provide a game (longest drive, hole-in-one, closest to the pin), we have to do it for all 3 courses to make it fair for all golfers.

The putting contest is at the end of the tournament for golfers once they finished their round and before going in for dinner.

Dinner is selected by the golfers during online registration and given a ticket in their registration package. They have the choice of perch, pickerel, steak, chicken or ribs. The meal also comes with a garden salad, pasta marinara, roasted potatoes, and fresh vegetable medley. Golfers then get to use the ticket to redeem dinner whenever they want. We are so luck to have her join the board! No one has the incite into the running of our day to day office routine like she does.


As a result of Denise joining the Board we advertized for a new Events Co-ordinator.

The Windsor Police Service is looking for 2-4 volunteers for their Active Attacker Training Days and would like to see if our volunteers would be interested. They will be every Tuesday from now until the week of June, 2023 and will start up again in September, 2023.

If you participate, you will need to sign a waiver prior to arrival.

Please do not email our contact at Windsor Police, Cst. Gratton, or myself that you will be attending. Book a spot by clicking on the link above only.

If you clicked you could attend and can no longer attend prior to the day of, please email me u can no longer attend on the day of, please email Cst. Gratton.

Those who are a no-show on the day of will no longer be considered for the volunteer positions going forward.

Please read the email below with instructions from Cst. Gratton on where you will be and what you are expected to do on these days. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to send me an email and I will get back to you when I am in office.

Please arrive at 1245hrs and report to the rear entrance of the STAG located at 3735 King St. Once all have arrived report to the Community Safety officer's vehicle and advise them to contact the safety officer inside. The safety officer will then conduct safety checks and issue the safety brief. They will then make their way inside the building. All personnel are required to either have eye protection or full face protection during the scenarios. A mask will be provided to the actors.

I would recommend wearing clothing that they wouldn't mind getting dirty as they will be playing our wounded victims (laying on the ground etc.). The STAG can be cold, bring any weather dependent clothing like coats and gloves. Leave all tools, knives and use of force at home.

\*Do not enter the premise unless escorted by a safety officer and safety checked. All volunteers must sign a waiver before participating.

This is a major fund raiser for us and we plan to have lots of tasty game dishes, raffle and auction items for your entertainment.



Thank you to everyone who participated in the event and to the organizers and volunteers that made the day a success!




#### THE PLAQUE SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM

#### **AUGUST PASTA NIGHT FUNDRAISERS**


The Pasta Night fundraisers will be every Wednesday in August 2023 at The Riverside Sportsmen Club!
