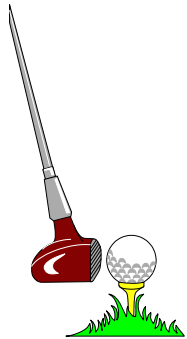


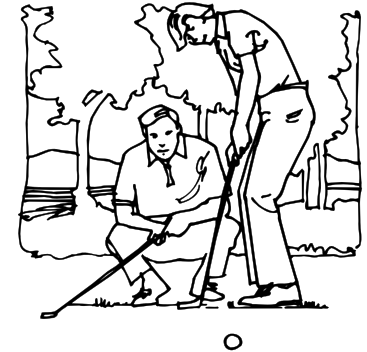
## GAME DINNER NOV. 17TH

### CRIME STOPPERS FUNDRAISING EVENT

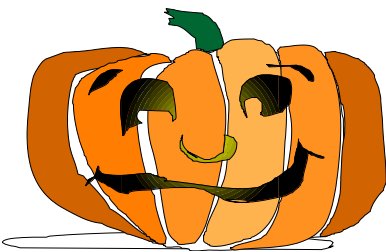

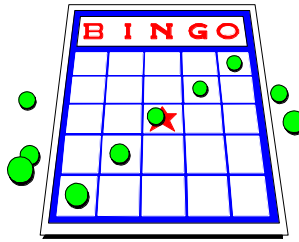

The event raised \$775.50.



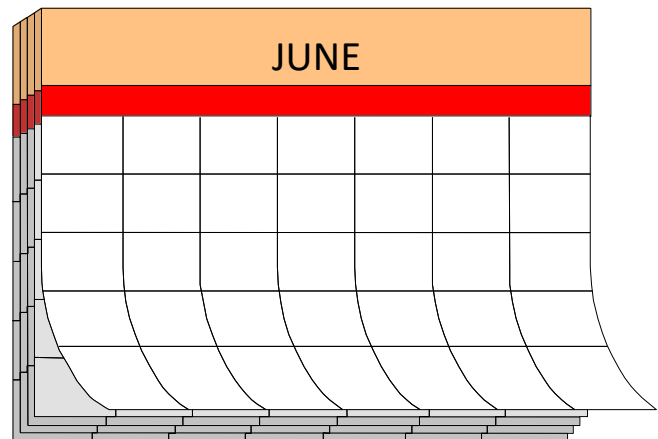

Thank you to everyone who purchased a ticket and to all those who sold the tickets.



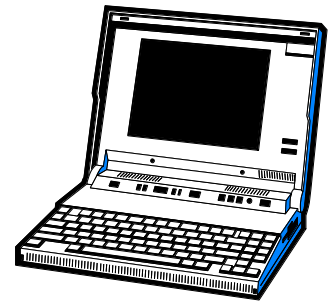
## E-TRANSFER NOW POSSIBLE

Through Lauren's efforts, she was able to have 2 new laptop computers donated to the program from Best Buy.

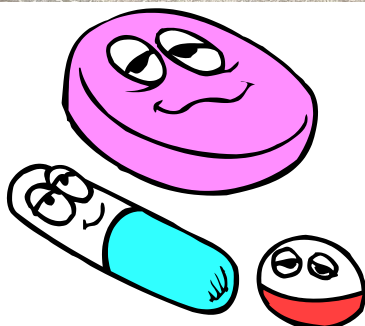
